I, Robert Jones of Kane, Pennsylvania, witnessed from the window of my house which is some distance from the Wolf Yard an occasion when Dr. McCleery entered the yard of Achilles, a large male Lobo Wolf which would attack any person if the opportunity were offered him. I saw Dr. McCleery enter the yard in an effort to tame the wolf. Achilles knocked the Doctor down and stood over him snapping at his face. However, the doctor managed to regain his feet. I went over and entered the yard after the Doctor succeeded in attaching a collar and chain to Achilles. The wolf leaped for my throat but I guarded him off with my hand which he lacerated badly, and was only prevented from a worse attack by the Doctor wrapping the chain around a tree and snapping it fast.

On another occasion Dr. McCleery was in what we call the vestibule, a small enclosure in the center of the yards into which all the yards open by gates, when two wolves attacked him, a Lobo and a White Arctic. He defended himself by striking them with a two by four until I came to his rescue. I was opening the gate but before I entered Jerry put his head through the large opening in the wire and grabbed my clothes. By throwing myself backwards quickly I prevented myself from being dragged closer to the white Arctic Wolf so she could not get hold of me. No one was injured in this fight.
