I, Robert Jones, of Kane, Pennsylvania, have witnessed two attacks by Lobo Wolves upon the person of Evan Gustafson (now deceased) who was in the employ of Dr. E. H. McCleery as tender of the Wolf Pack. On one occasion Mr. Gustafson and I entered the yard to separate two fighting wolves, one of which killed the other. We were attacked by the surviving wolf, which jumped on the head and shoulders of Mr. Gustafson and grabbed his hat and tore it to pieces. It was necessary for me to drive the wolf off Mr. Gustafson. On another occasion one of the wolves attacked Mr. Gustafson and tore his clothes considerably. Dr. McCleery grabbed the wolf and held it until he (Gustafson) escaped from the pen.
