I, Myrtle Jarensky, testify that I was present when Dr. E. H. McCleery was attacked by a female Lobo Wolf. He fortunately had a bucket in his hand with which he warded her off and also a piece of gas pipe with which he struck her and escaped without injury. A Lobo on one occasion grabbed me by the sleeve and tore the sleeve to shreds ruining my clothes, and she did not desist from the attack until Dr. McCleery struck her on the head several times before he succeeded in protecting me until I escaped from the gate. I have been secretary of the business of the Wolf Pack for the last eleven years.
