I, Robert Jones, of Kane, Pennsylvania, was superintendent of the McCleery Wolf Pack from 1921-1929, during which period I was attacked by the Lobo Wolves on four occasions and threatened innumerable other times. I was bitten twice. On one occasion Boreas and Diana, a pair of white Arctic Wolves had escaped from their yards into the runways and were fighting a pair of Lobo Wolves through the wire. Dr. McCleery and I entered the runways carrying gas pipes in our hands. They paid no attention to us until we were fifty feet from the gate when suddenly they ceased fighting and tried to double team me, one in front and one in back. I backed against the fence and Dr. McCleery threw himself upon Boreas and held him down talking to him. I slowly made my way toward the gate fighting off Diana while the wolves in the yard behind me were trying to attack me through the wire.
